- Monday, June 22: Pond Eddy (N.Y.) to Airport Park (Matamoras, Pa.); camp at Worthington State Forest, N.J.
- Tuesday, June 23: Smithfield Beach (Pa.) to Delaware Beach (Knowlton Twp., N.J.); camp at Worthington State Forest, N.J.
- Wednesday, June 24: Delaware Beach (Knowlton Twp., N.J.) to Riverton Park (Lower Mt. Bethel Twp., Pa.); camp at Washington Crossing State Park, N.J.
