

Driving Directions to Phillipsburg Boat Launch from Driftstone Campground 30 minutes, 19 miles

Start: Driftstone Campground, 2755 River Rd, Mt Bethel, PA 18343

- Take River Rd and Deer Run Dr to PA-611 S in Lower Mount Bethel Township 12 min (6.4 mi)
- Follow PA-611 S to Northampton St Bridge in Easton 18 min (12.6 mi)
- Turn left onto the Northampton St Bridge, cross the bridge and immediately turn left (don't go all the way to the traffic light) on to Riverside Way.
 2 min (0.2 mi)
- Destination is Riverside Way Parking Lot, 2 Riverside Way, Phillipsburg, NJ 08865
